2. Adoption of the Agenda

3. Adoption of the Minutes

The minutes were adopted with two additions that were added to New/Other Business.

4. <u>Business Arising from the Minutes</u>

a. <u>Dianne Whalen Drive Street Lighting</u>

The Committee asked for an update on the Dianne Whalen Drive Street Lighting. Staff informed the committee the Town and Newfoundland Power are working together on the easement agreement.

5. <u>Business Arising from the Council Meeting</u>

6. New/Other Business

a. <u>Cost Recovery – Transformer Failure</u>

The Cost Recovery - Transformer Failure was provided for information. Staff submitted the full amount of the contractor and material costs to Newfoundland Power and the full amount was reimbursed to the Town.

b. Recommend of Award - Black Box Radars
