BACKGROUND

The Town of Paradise works to maintain safety standards at all of its facilities. It has been identified that there is a need for required safety precautions for individuals using the ice surfaces at the Paradise Double Ice Complex.

OBJECTIVE/PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to ensure that all users of ice surfaces and participants of on ice activities wear a Canadian Standard Association (CSA) approved helmet. Users are advised that all CSA certified helmets have a sticker indicating their certification.

POLICY STATEMENT

A CSA approved helmet must always be worn by users of ice surfaces at the Paradise Double Ice Complex (i.e., from before entering the ice surface until after leaving). This applies to all ages, and includes all public users and private renters, such as anyone on the ice at public skating sessions, sporting events, during private events, camps, and school group visits etc. This policy also applies to Town of Paradise staff and contractors. Exceptions may exist for organizations that are protected by their own insurances and rules, such as figure skating clubs.

REVIEW OF POLICY

This policy is reviewed as required and is subject to change following new experiences or knowledge.
