1. The meeting was called to order by Chairperson English at 7:34 p.m.

2. **ADOPTION OF THE MINUTES:**

M13-240 Moved by Councillor Burton, seconded by Councillor Quilty to adopt the Minutes of the August 20, 2013 Public Meeting.

Motion carried.

3. BUSINESS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES:

There was no business arising from the Minutes.

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4. FINANCE DEPARTMENT:

1. Accounts for Payment

M13-241 Moved by Councillor Quilty, seconded by Councillor Burton that invoices in the amount of \$394,507.95 be approved for payment as submitted by the Director of Corporate Services.

Motion carried.

5. **PERMITS:**

1. M13-242 Moved by Councillor Bobbett, seconded by Councillor Laurie to approve application of Bell Mobility, DA13-0713, to install a 3.0 m cellular antenna on top of the Town's water tower at 3A Camrose Drive subject to three (3) conditions.

Motion carried.

2. M13-243 Moved by Councillor Willis, seconded by Councillor Quilty to approve application of Steve Saunders & Brandon Copeland, DA13-0894, for development approval for 7 residential lots at 3 & 5 Holland Place and 2-10 Holland Place subject to eighteen (18) conditions.

Motion carried.

3. M13-244 Moved by Councillor Willis, seconded by Councillor Laurie to approve application of Bill Shea (The Bakery D'Or), DA13-0728, for expansion to bakery into the next unit to accommodate more production area and expand bakery to include eat-in cafe at 1187 Kenmount Road, Unit #1 subject to nine (9) conditions.

- 4. M13-245 Moved by Councillor Laurie, seconded by Councillor Burton to reject application of Jack Lynch, DA13-0723, to construct a 45 square meter accessory building and remove root cellar at 134 Paradise Road for the following reasons:
 - 1. The proposed extension was referred to the City of St. John's in accordance with Section 2 of the Town of Paradise/City of St. John's Watershed Agreement and condition #4 of the Residential Watershed Use Zone of the Town of Paradise Municipal Plan & Development Regulations, 2004 which states that "all development applications will be referred to the City of St. John's for approval."

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5. **PERMITS:**

4. M13-245 (cont'd)

The City rejected the application at the Regular Meeting of the St. John's Development Committee (copy attached). As such, the proposed development is deemed to be in contravention with the Town of Paradise Development Regulations, 2004, specifically Section 6 which states, "Development shall be carried out in accordance with the Municipal Plan, these Regulations, and the conditions stated in a Permit to Develop".

Section 104 of the City of St. John's Act states that the City of St. John's has the discretionary power to allow development in specified circumstances. The City of St. John's is not prepared to exercise its discretionary powers in order to permit the proposed development. It is the City of St. John's policy that only one (1) specific dimensioned accessory building per building lot in the Broad Cover River Watershed is allowed. Where there is a built accessory building (commercial garage) on the subject building lot, no other accessory building can be allowed.

Motion carried.

5. M13-246 Moved by Councillor Bobbett, seconded by Councillor Laurie to approve application of Hubert Murphy Ltd., DA13-0089, to remove rear structure (train cars) and replace with wooden structure; repair front section of an existing commercial garage at 208 Paradise Road subject to six (6) conditions.
