With the record snow fall that hit our Town and our region, we want to remind residents to keep safety top of mind as they are doing snow clearing, driving and walking:

- When snow clearing, lift light loads, take breaks and drink lots of water. It's
 going to take time to clear this amount of snow.
- If you must drive, be aware of people snow clearing and walking. Also, watch
 for snow clearing equipment and emergency vehicles and yield them the right
 of way.
- We recommend residents to wear bright or reflective clothing when snow clearing or out walking to make it easier for crews to see them.
- We also ask kids not to play in snow banks or near roadways.
- Residents are asked to not push snow onto roads when clearing driveways and to move vehicles off the street when snow clearing equipment is in their area.
