f. Residential Property Tax Assistance Program

Director Smith advised the committee that during the budget process Council approved a residential property tax assistance program for residents that would fall within the low-income category. There will be 20% tax reduction for residents with lower household income and the threshold for this would follow the Guaranteed Income Supplement guidelines from Service Canada. To avail of this program, residents would have to provide a 2023 Notice of Assessment from Revenue Canada and apply for this program every year. A policy will be developed for formal approval of Council. The committee agreed to prepare an e poll of council to ensure the policy is approved when the tax invoices are received by residents.
