a. Purchase of New Zamboni

Committee discussed the purchase of a new Zamboni and recommend proceeding with the purchase of a new 2024 Zamboni 650 LI Electric Ice Resurfacer and battery charger from Saunders Equipment Ltd through the Canoe Sports Arena Supply Program.

b. Paradise Park Master Plan

c. Active NL Grant

Staff provided a copy of the Active NL Grant funding approval letter and were informed that a functional trainer was purchased for the Fitness Centre which will provide better accessibility options for everyone.

d. Accessibility Plan

e. Nevaeh's Lemonade Stand 2024

Committee discussed a rental request that was received for June of this year for Nevaeh's Lemonade Stand and recommend charging 50% of the staffing costs, a discounted rental rate of 50% off the daily rate and the cost of the forklift rental to lay and remove the ice covering.

f. Trail Networks Strategy

Committee discussed the trail networks in the Town and suggested that staff work with the Planning and Protective Services department to create an improved trail network for the community.
