#### **Additional ATIPP Information**

- The average time to process and close an ATIPP request in 2024 was 16.5 business days. Excluding outlier requests (i.e., extensions) the average was 14 business days.
- 11 of 22 responses in 2024 were categorized as 'Full Disclosure.' The most frequently applied exception to access, applied in 10 responses, was Section 40 a mandatory exception to protect personal privacy. Discretionary exceptions included: S29, Policy Advice (3); S28, Local Confidences (1); S39 Harmful to Businesses (1).
- Since the implementation of the ATIPP Act in 2016, the Town has processed 181 ATIPP requests, averaging 21 requests annually. The table below provides information on requests per year.
