BACKGROUND

This policy replaces the previously adopted "Installation of Sidewalks" from August 17, 2007 (M04-257).

PURPOSE/OBJECTIVE

Provide direction and guidelines to determine the appropriate means to accommodate pedestrians on existing Town roads.

POLICY STATEMENT

To ensure the health, safety and well-being of pedestrians within the Town of Paradise, the following guidelines have been put in place regarding the installation of sidewalks. All sidewalks will be installed as per the Town Engineering Guidelines at the cost of the developer.

GUIDELINES AND PROCEDURES

Concrete sidewalks are required to be installed on all new services streets in the Town of Paradise as follows:

- (i) Arterial Roads- Both Sides
- (ii) Collector Roads- Both Sides
- (iii) Local Road- One side unless pedestrian generator in area (i.e. schools, church, shopping center, etc.)

All existing serviced streets in the Town of Paradise fronting new commercial/industrial developments require the installation of concrete sidewalks.

REVIEW: This policy will be subject to review one year following implementation.
