

Easter Activity Sheet

Bean Bag Game

Setup:

Set up two targets (Pitcher's box) on opposite sides of your yard at a distance you feel comfortable with. If you do not own a pitcher's box, you can simply mark a section of your yard with some ribbon, bucket, etc. You will also need four bean bags per player.





How to Play:

- Bean Bag is played in rounds or innings, wherein each round, players
 take turns throwing bean bags at the opposing target. All shots must be
 taken behind your own target.
- Once all the bags have been thrown, you can tally your points based on where your bags landed. If it's on the box, it's 1 point, and if it's in the hole, it's 3 points. (Reference the image above)
- If you have more points than your opponent, you win that inning, and whoever wins the most innings by the end is the winner!
